

Pad Printing Clean Up procedure

To clean up your pad printer you will need the following items:

- At least 16oz. SC19 ink cleaner
- 1 gallon plastic pale or equivalent
- 1½” wide inexpensive paint brush (trim bristles if too soft/long)
- paper towels
- trash can lined with a plastic bag.
- Plastic milk jug or equivalent
- Plastic gloves

Cleaning Steps:

1. Take the plastic jug and cut the top off.
2. Turn the top upside down and place it in the bottom and staple it in place.
3. Pour the pad cleaner in the plastic pale (not the jug)Using two pales with ½ gallon cleaner works best
4. Take the ink cup and the plate out of the machine.
5. Turn the plate and cup upside down(so the ink will stay in the cup.)
6. Put on gloves if you have not done so already.
7. Pull the plate off of the cup.
8. Put the cup upside down in the milk jug top to drain.
9. Wipe ink off of he plate with the paper towels and clean off with the SC19
10. After the cup has drained awhile wipe the cup out with the paper towel as best as you can.
11. Place the cup in the SC19 and clean out with the brush.
12. This is where it is best to have two pales with cleaner because you can put the cup in the second pale to clean it farther
13. Remove the thinner cap and clean out the threads.
14. Remove the cup and wipe dry.
